CONTACT US IF ...

...your child displays unusual behaviour, such as:

EARLY SPECIAL EDUCATION:

- developing slowly, playing in an odd manner
- avoiding eye contact and physical contact
- constantly screaming and being almost impossible to calm
- appearing apathetic or excessively well-behaved
- communication or contact difficulties, considerable anxiety, lack of emotional detachment
- longstanding eating or sleeping problems
- a "pain in the neck", "fidget", "petty tyrant"
- development at risk due to major family-related trauma

EARLY SPEECH THERAPY

- delayed language acquisition, only speaks a few words
- pronounces words incorrectly
- says words in wrong order or makes incomplete sentences
- fails to understand spoken instructions or questions
- stutters over a long period of time
- hardly communicates with other children or adults, withdraws or becomes aggressive

... the strengths and weaknesses your child demonstrates. In **early special education**, we assess your child's abilities in all developmental areas, while in **early speech therapy**, the focus is on language and communication. We discuss the next steps together with you. The assessment forms the basis for targeted support and advice.

... your child's abilities with playful activities. You, as parents, are involved in fostering your child's development. In **early special education**, we support children with playing, thinking, movement, awareness and social behaviour. In **early speech therapy**, we promote children's speech and communication skills. We work out the educational targets together with you. Your child's therapy takes place primarily at your home, but also in our education centre, on an individual or small-group basis.

We also advise playgroup leaders, daycare staff and other specialists.
